Our team of skilled support workers enable all of our customers to live as independently as possible, either in their own home or in our Heart of England Mencap properties. We also support families and carers by offering short breaks and respite care. To enable our customers to experience a meaningful day we offer a range of coordinated day activity programmes across five locations.

We enable all the people we support to live the life they choose, focussing on their abilities rather than their disabilities.
